"Study of attitudes towards the problem of smoking among students of Universities and Medical Universities in Łódź and Warsaw"

ABSTRACT

Smoking tobacco products in Poland and in the world is a significant health-economic problem. Leading to addiction to nicotine, people suffer from a number of health complications often requiring medical intervention. A cause-and-effect relationship has been proven in many disease entities, including lung cancer, cardiovascular diseases such as ischemic heart disease and stroke, as well as chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) and various respiratory conditions.
